**“WITH THE YOUTH WE  
PROCLAIM THE GOSPEL”.**

Pope Francis has called every man and woman to be a part of mission. In his World Mission Day message, he speaks especially to the youth to take an active role in mission, however, also reminds us that mission revitalises faith and that all Christians are called to mission as we are children of God.

From the Pope's message:

“The Pontifical Mission Societies (MISSIO) were born of young hearts as a means of supporting the preaching of the Gospel to every nation and thus contributing to the human and cultural growth of all those who thirst for knowledge of the truth. The prayers and the material aid generously given and distributed through the Pontifical Mission Societies enable the Holy See to ensure that those who are helped in their personal needs can in turn bear witness to the Gospel lives. No one is so poor as to be unable to give what they have, but first and foremost what they are. Let me repeat the words of encouragement that I addressed to the young people of Chile:

‘never think that you have nothing to offer, or that nobody needs you.  
Many people need you. Think about it! Each of you, think in your heart:  
many people need me’.

To live out joyfully our responsibility for the world is a great challenge. The fact that we are not in this world by our own choice makes us sense that there is an initiative that precedes us and makes us exist. Each one of us is called to reflect on the fact : I am a mission on this Earth; that is the reason why I am here in this world”.
