All Souls Day, Friday Nov 2. Masses at 10.00 am and 7 pm. The Mass at 7 pm is a Special Commemoration Mass to remember all those who passed away during the year. Parishioners are invited to light a candle in remembrance of a deceased relative or friend. There will be no First Friday Mass at 6 pm.
