The House Of God

At the time the prophet Isaiah was writing (First Reading) there were a lot of foreigners living in Israel. The question arose as to whether or not the benefits of salvation should be extended to them. Sadly, instead of being a force for unity, religion has often been the cause of conflict and division. Nevertheless, it has a great capacity to break down barriers. Of all the things that draw people together, worshipping together has the power to turn them into a loving family.

Isaiah gave a clear and positive answer: God's house is to be a house of prayer for *all* the people.

'My house shall be a house of prayer for all the people.' This is a huge statement. God's house is open to all his children.

In the house of God there are no first and last. This is because all of us are equal before God. For one small hour the high and mighty descend and the lowly rise. And in the house of God there are no special seats. This is because in the house of God every place is a place of honour.

The church is a temple with a hundred of gates and pilgrims enter from every angle. Through every door and from all kinds of paths, we enter the house of God on a Sunday morning. For the most part, a church is associated with Sunday worship. But it remains open all week long. Anyone can come here at any hour of the day to talk to God, to seek his help in times of trouble, his guidance in times of doubt, or just to be near the Lord in the hope of tasting the peace this world cannot seem to give.

Many lost, lonely, homeless souls have come to the house of God, or have wandered almost by accident and felt at home there. In God's house we discover who we are. Whatever the world may think of us, in God's house we know who we are. We are God's precious sons and daughters.

The house of God is a place beyond earning, deserving and rewarding. It is a place of surrender and complete trust. It is a place of prayer that through the presence of God becomes a place of blessing. We must strive to make this place of worship a house of prayer, joy and unity. And when we leave the church, we must try to take with us a spirit of joy and having extended a warm welcome towards each other.
