#### The Best Is The Enemy Of The Good

Tom was a farmer. One day he was doing his spring ploughing when the king's messenger appeared unexpectedly in his field. The messenger informed him that he had been invited to the royal banquet. On hearing this Tom began to glow like a full moon. In a flash, his monotonous life was transformed.

'When exactly is the banquet?' he asked.

'Tonight,' the messenger replied, adding, 'I will be back in about an hour for your answer.' With that he departed.

The banquet was to be held that very night! This changed things. Tom looked back over the work he had done. It was going well. Then he looked ahead at what remained to be done. With luck he could finish it today. Then he considered the oxen - he was still breaking them in. And this was something that should not be interrupted.

At that moment he looked up and saw the royal messenger going into his neighbour's field. So that man was being invited too! Suppose, as was quite possible, he would be sitting next to him at the table? All of a sudden the banquet began to lose some of its appeal.

Then there was the tedious business of getting washed and changed. And what clothes would he wear? Even his best suit was hardly good enough for a royal banquet and he would hate to look shabby in the presence of the king and all the other guests.

Tom began to have second thoughts. He thought if only the banquet was happening tomorrow night, the ploughing would have been done and he wouldn't be thinking twice about going. By the time the messenger came back his mind was made up - he was not going. He gave a litany of excuses to the messenger who clearly was in a hurry to get back to the palace. Notice that the things that kept Tom from going were not bad things, but perfectly reasonable - the cares of work and life. But this is precisely what makes them so dangerous. We don't see how this can jeopardize our entire life.

Here the *banquet* stands for the fullness of life to which God is calling us. It is a call to intimacy with God and a call to community with others. The invitation challenges us to abandon our isolationism, our self-sufficiency and exclusivism and to associate with others. The aim of the parable is to help us to see what we will be missing if we do not heed God's invitation. Those who refuse to come miss out on the joy of the wedding feast.

#### **Guest Speaker - Br. Johnson Sequeira**


Come One, Come All....receive the blessing, healing and the love of our faithful God.


