Let Us Walk In The Light Of The Lord

The theme of light figures prominently in today's readings. Isaiah urges 'to walk in the light of the Lord'. And St Paul urges us to turn away from darkness and live in the light. But what in practice does this entail?

There was a wise and learned rabbi. One day he turned to his pupils and asked the following question: 'How can you tell when the night is passed and the day is on its way back again?' One said, 'When you see an animal in the distance and you can tell whether it is a sheep or a goat.'

Another said, 'When you see a tree in the distance and you can tell whether it is a fig tree or a peach tree.'

Yet another said, 'When you can see a person in the distance, and you can tell whether it is friend or an enemy.'

There were a number of other answers. But the rabbi was not impressed. His pupils pleaded with him to tell them his answer. And he replied as follows: 'It is when you can look at the face of any human being and see there the face of a brother or a sister, because if you cannot do this then no matter what time of the day it is, for you it is still night.'

We are the people on whom the light of Christ has shone and still shines. We must, therefore, strive to walk in the light of truth and life, the light of holiness and grace, the light of justice, love and peace.

Nonetheless, darkness still has power over us. And it takes courage to recognize the darkness in our lives. There is no joy in living in darkness. But with God's grace we can free ourselves from the darkness and experience the joy of walking in the light. The shortest journey to the light is by doing good. The most precious light of all is the light of love. Without it the world would be a very dark place. Love lights up everything and it brings hope. People who love shed light around them. They are like a lamp alight and shinning. The image of God is at its best and brightest in us when we love.

Those who live in the light have nothing to fear from the Lord's coming. We are being told to welcome it.
