Vision Of A New World

The astronauts were the first human beings to see the earth from space. As they gazed down on the earth from space, they realized as never before that we are one family, with spaceship Earth as our common home. One of them said later: 'The first day in space, we all pointed to our own countries. The second day, we pointed to our continents, By the third day, we were aware of only one Earth.'

The prophets had the same kind of high and wide vision. Isaiah dreamt of a world in which the wolf would lie down with the lamb. A world in which those who were furthest apart from each other would be united in friendship. His vision offers us hope when we are tempted to despair and courage when we are tempted to give up. But how real is this vision? Sadly to say that when one reads a history book, or even just the daily newspaper, at times we feel ashamed to be human. What is human history if not wars and more wars? The world is drenched in blood.

As for the wolf and the lamb living together, often two neighbours, or even two members of the same family, have a falling out and refuse to talk to one another. Should all hope be abandoned?

The prophets lived in the real world and were just as dismayed by the horrors and injustices as we are. Yet through faith in God they continued to dream of a new world, a world free from injustice and war.

And the prophets were people with a vision, they were people with hope. They were fiercely committed. They held a bright vision up before us, a vision unrealisable to humans alone, but realisable with the help of God.

The marvellous vision of the peaceable kingdom is not an escapist dream. Jesus had a word for the new world. He called it the 'Kingdom of God'. It was to establish this kingdom that he came on earth. He inaugurated it. And he now wants his followers to dedicate themselves to the building of that kingdom.

Far from encouraging us to escape from real life, this beautiful vision summons us to get involved. Even though it is a struggle we will never win completely, the struggle is good for us. It awakens everything that is important to us - every time we show compassion, work for peace and justice, forgive a person - we are helping the vision to become a reality.


