A reading from the gospel according to John.....adapted for children

One day Jesus said:

I am the Good Shepherd,

When Jesus was alive on earth sheep were very important to people so being a shepherd was an important job.

They had to protect the sheep from hungry wolves.

Not all shepherds did a good job of looking after the sheep.

Jesus called himself the Good Shepherd and we are his sheep.

He will always look after us. He was even prepared to die for us.

Let's sit quietly now and think of God's story.

Unpacking the Gospel

•What does Jesus call himself in this story? Why?
•What do YOU think makes a GOOD SHEPHERD?
• Jesus said he was prepared to die for his sheep"
What do YOU think he is referring to? (Calvary—dying on the cross)

Message Jesus tells us he is the Good Shepherd to help us understand how much he loves us. WE ARE HIS FLOCK. He CARES for each one of us. He WATCHES over each one of us. He KNOWS each one of us by name.
