A reading from the gospel according to Matthew.....adapted for children

Jesus told his disciples to go to a mountain.

When they got there Jesus appeared, they were amazed.

Jesus said to them:

**“All power in heaven and on earth
has been given to me, and I am sending
you out into the world to make disciples of all peoples.**

**Baptise them in the name of the
Father and of the Son and of the
Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey
all the commandments I have given to you
and remember that I will always be with you.”**

Let's sit quietly now and think of God's story.

Unpacking the Gospel

Why were the disciples amazed to see Jesus?

(This meeting happened when Jesus had died on the cross so the disciples thought he was dead.)

What has Jesus asked us to do?

(Go out and teach people about him and spread his love)

Jesus promises to be with us and help us.

Invite the children to make the sign of the cross and remind them that Jesus will always be with them.

And all that He continues to do

Help us to trust in you

Even when we don't understand what's happening

In Jesus name, Amen!

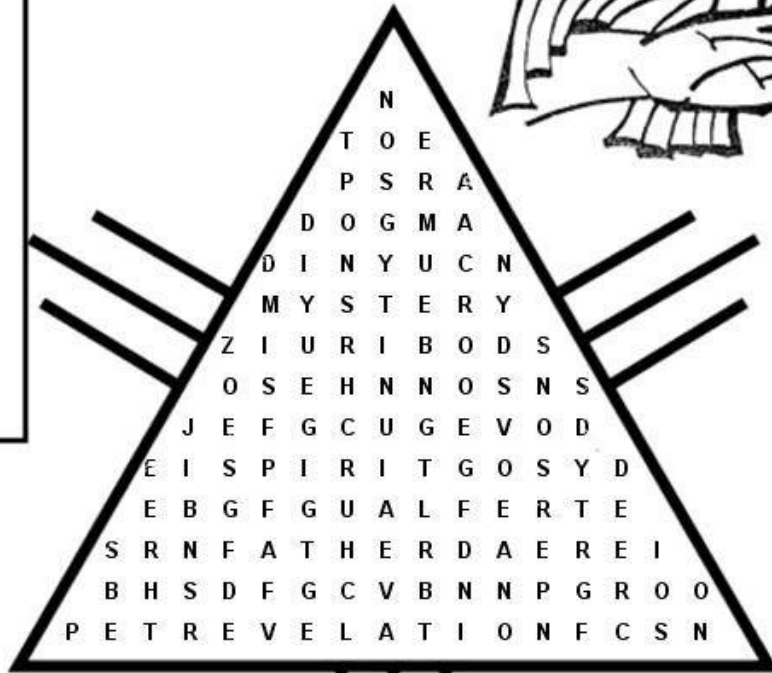
