**Today we are going to be talking about
Jesus talked about his mission.
Let's, listen and hear the story Jesus tells his followers.**

A reading from the gospel according to John.....adapted for children

“Where do you want us to get the feast ready?”

The friends of Jesus asked.

Jesus said.

“Go into the city, a man carrying a pot of water will meet you.

Follow him and speak to the owner of the house he goes in to.

Tell him: The Teacher says, where is the room where I may eat the Passover feast with my friends? The owner himself will show you a large paved room upstairs. Get ready for us there.”

The friends went away into the city and everything went just as Jesus said.

Jesus and his disciples gathered together to celebrate the Passover meal together.

While they were eating, Jesus took some bread, gave thanks to God, broke the bread and gave a piece to each of his disciples saying,

“Take this and eat it, this is my body.”

Then he took a cup of wine. Again, he praised God, and passed it to each of his disciples saying,

“Take this and drink it, this is my blood, poured out for you.

Do this in memory of me.”
