A reading from the gospel according to Mark.....adapted for children

**Jesus called together his twelve special friends,
and sent them out, two by two. He told them
to take nothing for the journey: no food; no
haversack; no money in their wallets; not even
a spare tunic; they were to wear sandals on their feet.**

Jesus said to them,

**“Stay in any house where you are made
welcome. If you're not made welcome, and
if the people refuse to listen to you, walk away
from them, and shake the dust from your feet.”**

**So they set out two by two, as Jesus instructed them,
teaching and preaching, helping the people and healing the sick**

Let's sit quietly now and think of God's story.

Unpacking the Gospel

- if you were going on a long journey, what sort of things would you want to take with you?
(Clothes, shoes, toiletries etc)
- why do you think Jesus told his friends not to take anything with them?
(so they could be really free)
- wouldn't they need some of these things?
(not if they were staying with people who made them welcome)
- the apostles were carrying something very precious—do you know what it was?
The GOOD NEWS—and like the apostles, we too can share Christ's message with the people we meet everyday
- how can you be GOOD NEWS people this week
at home.....
at school.....
to yourself?

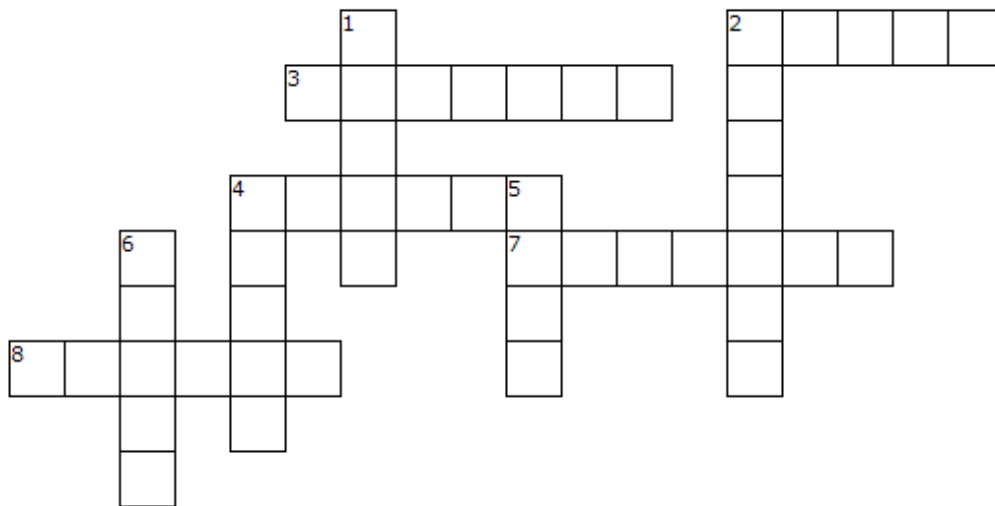
