What is the Transfiguration of Jesus?

Jesus changing his appearance, bright and shining.

Why is the Transfiguration of Jesus important?

Jesus shows His glory and gives a glimpse of heaven.

Who appeared with Jesus during the Transfiguration?

Moses and Elijah appeared with Jesus.

What did the voice from the cloud say during the Transfiguration of Jesus?

“This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to Him.”

Where did the Transfiguration of Jesus take place?

The Transfiguration of Jesus took place on a high mountain.

Who witnessed the Transfiguration of Jesus?

Peter, James, and John, they were three of His closest disciples.

What happened to Jesus' appearance during the Transfiguration?

Jesus' face shone like the sun, and His clothes became dazzling white.

What is the message of the Transfiguration of Jesus?

Jesus is the Son of God. It also shows the promise of seeing God's glory in heaven.

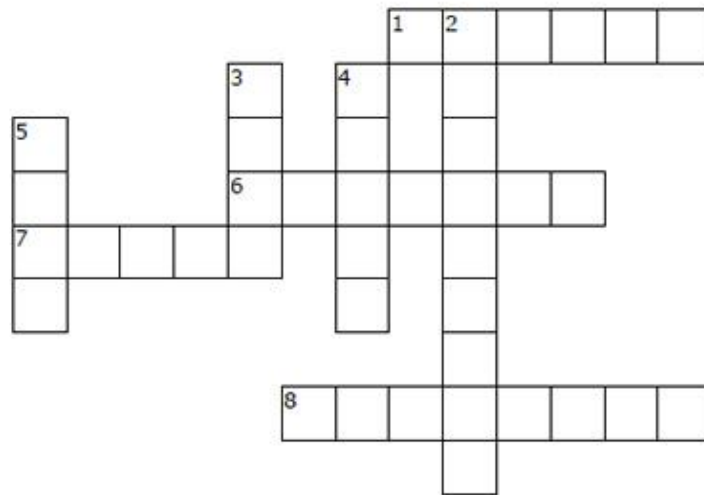

ACROSS

1. Ready to go to bed or take a nap
6. Things such as a dress or trousers that you wear to cover your body
7. The opposite of being asleep
8. A raised part of the Earth's surface, much larger than a hill

DOWN

2. A flash of bright light in the sky produced by electricity
3. The front of the head, where the eyes, nose and mouth are
4. A grey or white mass floating in the sky, made of very small drops of water
