**Today we are going to be talking about
Jesus talked about his mission.
Let's, listen and hear the story Jesus tells his followers.**

A reading from the gospel according to luke.....adapted for children'

Jesus was led by the Holy Spirit into the desert where he was tempted by the devil for forty days.

Jesus had not had anything to eat for forty days. He was hungry, and Satan knew he was hungry, so he said to him, "If you are really the Son of God, turn these stones into bread."

Jesus could have easily done what Satan suggested, but he didn't. Instead, he answered, "It is written, 'Man does not live by bread alone.'"

Then the devil took Jesus up to a high place and showed him the worldly kingdoms below. "All of this belongs to me," he said. "If you will bow down and worship me, I will give it to you."

Jesus answered, "It is written, 'Worship the Lord your God and serve him only.'"

Next, the devil took Jesus to Jerusalem and led him up to the highest point on the temple. He said to Jesus, "If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down from here. God will send his angels to rescue you."

Again, Jesus quoted the Scripture, "'Do not put the Lord your God to the test.'"

Do you know what the devil did? He gave up!

Let's sit quietly now and think of God's story.

Unpacking the Gospel

What does it mean to be tempted?

(The devil tries to get you to do bad things)

Where was Jesus when He was tempted?

(the desert wilderness)

What did Jesus do every time Satan tried to get Him to do wrong?

(He quoted a scripture from the Word of God)

What did the devil tempt Jesus with?

(pride, power, and popularity/using power for bread, testing God's power, and saving all people of the world)

Did Jesus do the things Satan tempted Him to do? (No)

Who took care of Jesus after he was tempted? (Angels)

Who experiences temptation? (every human, including Jesus)

What did you learn about God or Jesus in this story?

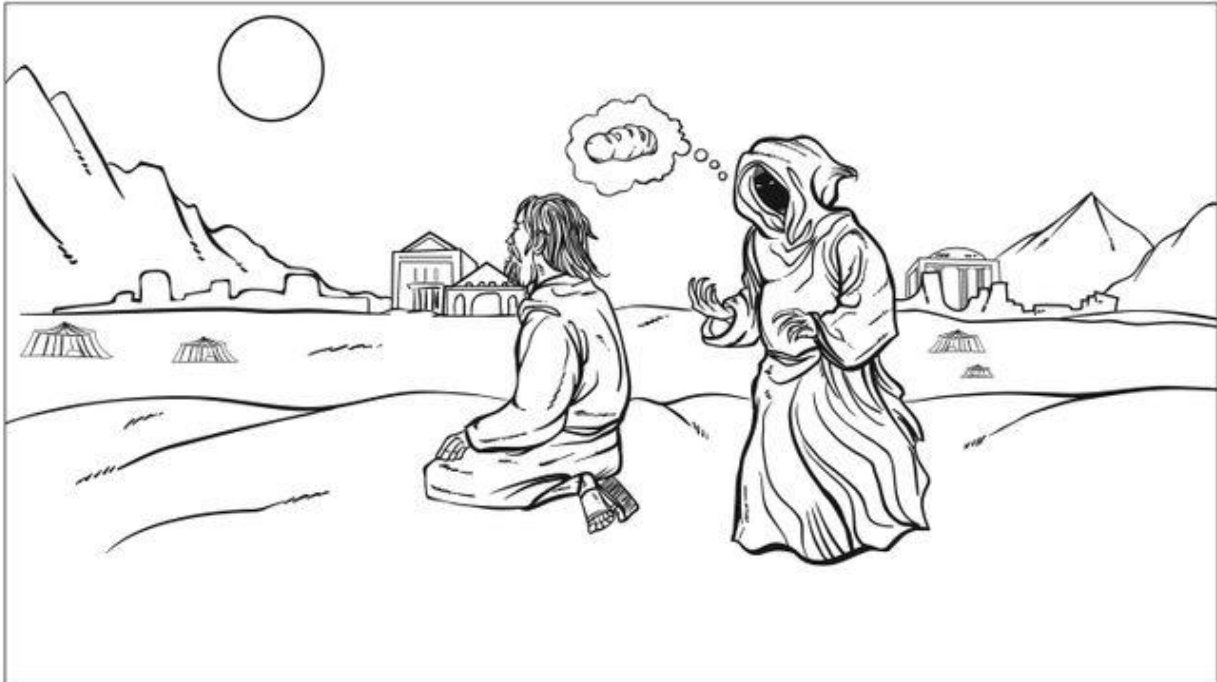

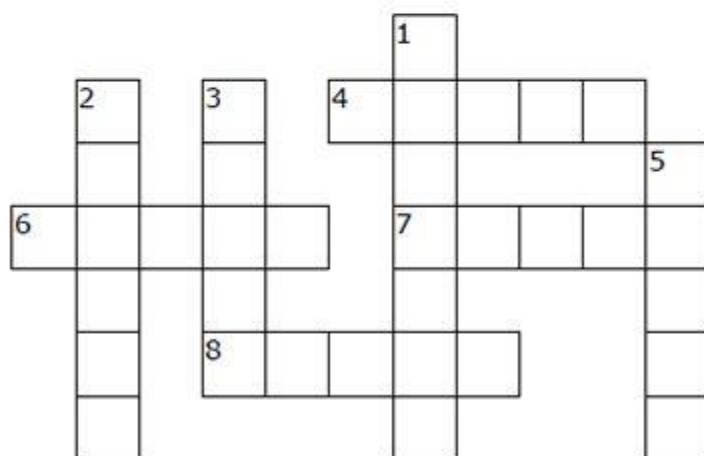
