It's The Heart That Matters

Israel needed a king. The first king of Israel, Saul, on whom such great hopes and expectations had been placed, had proved a failure and had been rejected by God. The prophet Samuel was commissioned by God to look for a new king. Samuel's search led him to Bethlehem and the household of Jesse. There, one by one, he was introduced to seven of Jesse's sons. All of them possessed outstanding physical attributes and Samuel was impressed. Yet he wasn't quite satisfied. So he continued his search.

He was looking for something else, something not so obvious, but which he felt he would recognize if and when he saw it. As he knew that there was one more to be seen, David was then introduced to him. A mere youth, he was still physically underdeveloped, he did not have a lot going for him. Today the image that you project has become more important than the reality and most times appearances can be deceptive. Everything that makes up the kernel of a person's character is hidden from us. In the memorable words of the Little Prince, '*What is essential is invisible.*'

While David didn't cut a good image, he did have something going for him. Samuel, a wise and perceptive man, noticed it at once. David had a good heart and he had a strong intimate connection to God.

As soon as Samuel saw David he knew that his search for a successor to Saul was over. David made a good king and is one of the most important figures in the Old Testament. That doesn't mean he was perfect. He sinned and sinned grievously but he always repented. Several times in the Gospel Jesus is referred to as '*Son of David*'.

David's heart was good. When all is said and done it is the heart that matters. Emptiness of heart is the greatest poverty of all.

In the Gospel story we see that the hearts of the Pharisees were in darkness. Not even Jesus, 'the light of the world' was able to bring light to them. As for the blind man, not only his eyes became bright but his heart was filled with light as a result of his encounter with Jesus.

While we tend to look at appearances, God looks at the heart. God sees what is in the heart. That is why only God can truly judge people.
