Let's, listen and hear the story Jesus tells his followers.

A reading from the gospel according to John.....adapted for children

Jesus had sent a message:

To his eleven friends to come to Galilee, and meet him on top of a hill.

So, they went to Galilee.

They climbed the hill.

And suddenly Jesus was there!

Jesus' friends were so happy to see him.

They had seen his miracles.

They had heard his wisdom.

And now, after he was dead and buried, they saw him alive again.

They worshiped him.

But some of the followers did not believe that it was really Jesus.

So, he came to them and said,

“All authority in heaven and on earth is given to me.

So go and make followers of all people in the world.

Baptize them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

Teach them to obey everything that I have told you to do.

You can be sure that I will be with you always.

I will continue with you until the end of time.”

Unpacking the Gospel

Where did Jesus meet his disciples after he rose from the dead?

(On a mountain in Galilee)

What big job did Jesus give his friends?

(To go and make disciples of all nations/people)

What are two things Jesus told them to do for new followers?

(Baptize them and teach them)

What do we understand about the Trinity?

Each Person of the Trinity is believed to be completely God.

God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit

Each member of the Trinity is different but 100% God. They're all equal. And they all share the same divine Nature.

The Trinity is like an egg. Just as ONE egg has THREE different parts – the shell, the white, the yoke – ONE God has THREE different Persons – Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Similarly, we often hear the Trinity compared to an Apple. ONE apple has three different parts – the skin, the flesh, and the seed.

Everywhere we go, help us show people

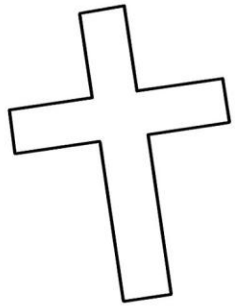
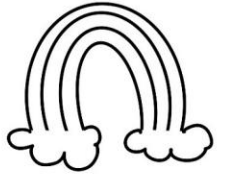
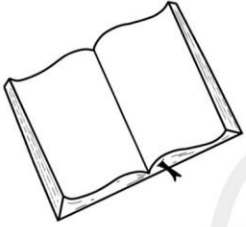
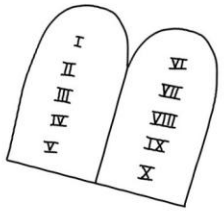
